ORDINANCE NO. 141

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE WITH LOUD OR DEFECTIVE MUFFLERS WITH LOUD OR DEFECTIVE MUFFLERS, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY:

Section 1: That cities of the fourth class, Foley being such, have the authority under Section 307.170 RSMo. to regulate the operation of motor vehicles as regards to their equipment.

Section 2: That it shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person operating a motor vehicle within the city limits to operate such vehicle with muffler cut outs. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in a manner or condition that causes excessive or unnecessary noise to be made by its machineries, motor, signaling device or other parts or by improperly loaded cargo.

Section 3: All motor vehicles shall be fitted with properly attached mufflers of capacity and construction as to quiet the maximum possible exhaust noise as completely as is done in modern gas engine passenger motor vehicles. Any cut out or opening in the exhaust pipe shall be completely closed and disconnected from its operating lever and shall be so arranged that it cannot automatically open or be opened or operated while the vehicle is in motion.

Section 4: That any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment in the Lincoln County Jail for up to ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its enactment and approval.
