

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE VIOLATION OF PEACE DISTURBANCE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY:

Section 1: That cities of the fourth class, Foley being such, have the authority under RSMo. 574.010 et seq. to regulate and prohibit peace disturbances within the municipal limits.

Section 2: For the purposes of this section the following words shall have the following definitions:

a) "Property of another" means any property in which the actor does not have a possessory interest.

b) "Private property" means any place which at the time is not open to the public. It includes property which is owned publicly or privately.

c) "Public place" means any place which at the time is open to the public. It includes property which is owned publicly or privately.

Section 3: A person violates the ordinance prohibiting peace disturbance if that person:

a) unreasonably and knowingly disturbs or alarms another person or persons by loud noise, or offense^v and indecent language which is likely to produce an immediate violent response from a reasonable recipient, or threatening to commit a crime against any person, or fight, or creating obnoxious or offense odor, or

b) is in a public place or private property of another without consent and purposefully causes inconvenience to a person or persons by unreasonably and physically obstructing vehicle or pedestrian traffic or free ingress or egress to or from a public or private place.

Section 4: A person additionally commits a violation of this ordinance if he is on private property and unreasonably and purposefully causes alarm to another person or persons on the same premises by threatening to commit a crime against any person or by fighting.

Section 5: That any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment in the Lincoln County Jail for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its enactment and approval.
