ORDINANCE NO. 167B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 135 BY EXPANDING THE PROHIBITION OF DISMANTLED OR INOPERABLE MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF FOLEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City of Foley adopted Ordinance No. 135 regulating the parking of motor vehicles open to public view within the City limits of Foley that are dismantled, wrecked, abandoned or inoperable and prohibiting the parking of motor vehicles anywhere but on driveways or parking lots, providing for removal of such vehicles and punishment of violators on the 15th day of November, 1989.

Section 2: That the Board of Aldermen of the City of Foley believe that while the citizens should have the privilege and the right to perform routine maintenance on inoperable vehicles in order to promptly repair them and render them operable in compliance with the Ordinance, the Board firmly feels that extensive repair to motor vehicles can create a danger and a threat to the citizens and also constitute a nuisance injurious to the public health and welfare.

Section 3: Accordingly, the Board does hereby amend Ordinance 135 by inserting in there a new Section 3.1 to be read in its entirety between the existing Section 3 and 4. The new Section to read as follows:

Section 3.1: Repair of Damaged or Disabled Vehicles. Any damaged or disabled vehicle or part thereof located on any property, street, or highway which could be considered an attractive nuisance and hazard to children or allows for the growth of tall grass, weeds or other vegetation or creates a fire hazard or affords a breeding place or nesting places for mosquitos is hereby prohibited. In particular, this Ordinance shall include the unattended suspension of car parts or material and the unattended suspension and securing of car parts or material above ground level in open areas.

Section 4: In all other regards, Ordinance 135 is hereby re-enacted and reincorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval.
