

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That cities of the fourth class, Foley Being such, have the power under ss79.450 RSMO to pass laws regulating the parking of certain vehicles within the City Limits of Foley, Missouri.

Section 2: RECREATIONAL VEHICLE, EQUIPMENT AND TRAILERS: shall be defined as

1. Pick-up camper. A structure designed primarily to be mounted on a pick-up truck chassis and with sufficient equipment to render it suitable for use as a temporary dwelling for travel, recreational and vacation uses.

2. Recreational vehicle. A recreational vehicle as used herein means a vehicle, whether self-propelled or a trailer, which is constructed with sufficient equipment to render it suitable for use as temporary dwelling for travel, recreation and vacation uses.

Section 3: Parking Requirements

1. No recreational vehicle as defined by this ordinance shall be parked on the street or adjacent right-of-way except those recreational vehicles temporarily parked while actively loading or unloading for a period of time not to exceed two (2) hours.

2. Recreation vehicles parked or stored shall not have fixed connections to electricity, water, gas or sanitary sewer facilities and at no time shall such recreational vehicles be used for living or housekeeping purposes.

3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to a recreacational vehicle temporarily parked in the a driveway or on private property for a period not to exceed a total of ten (10) days per calendar year for purposes of seasonal preparation. Utility connections related to vehicle preparation shall not exceed two (2) days.

Section 4: Any person found guilty of violation the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of committing a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of up to \$500.00 or imprisonment in the county jail for up to 90 days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon enactment and approval by the City Council.
