ORDINANCE NO. 189

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 152 TO REFLECT A VARIANCE TO BE OBTAINED FOR PURPOSES OF MEAT SHOOT SO AS TO NOT BE IN CONTROVERSION OF ORDINANCE NO. 152:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Cities of the 4th Class, Foley being such, have the authority under the revised statute of Missouri, Section 79.450, and Chapters 571 and 577, to regulate the possession and use of weapons.

Section 2: The City of Foley enacted Ordinance No. 152 on the 17th day of July, 1991.

Section 3: That Ordinance No. 152 is hereby amended with the following additions:

Section 8: Any person may make application, on a per event basis, to the City Clerk to obtain a permit for the purposes of conducting a meat shoot provided that the applicant meet the following requirements, per event:

- a. That the meat shoot will only be conducted only on Saturdays or Sundays from the hours of noon to dusk.
- b. That participants in the meat shoot shall only utilize shot guns. No rifles shall be authorized.
- c. That the event occur on property consisting of a minimum of five (5) acres.
- d. That applicant shall pay the sum of \$50.00 to be submitted to the City Clerk.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and enactment.
