

ORDINANCE NO. 209

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CITY PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Foley City Code is amended to add a new Chapter 30 -- City Parks and Recreational Facilities as follows:

CHAPTER 30 -- CITY PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

§30.010. DEFINITIONS

“City Park” means the Fischer Memorial Park located on Elm Street between McQuie and Mill Streets.

§30.030 RULES FOR USE OF THE CITY PARK

1. The City park shall be closed from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise. No person shall enter the City park during the hours it is closed.
2. No person shall throw or place, or cause to be thrown or placed, any glass, glass bottles, wire, nails, tacks, hedge, cans, garbage, trash, refuse, or rubbish of any kind, nature, or description in the City Park, with the exception that such items used in the Park may be placed in City designated refuse containers.
3. No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, misuse, destroy, uncover, deface or tamper with any City-owned structure, appurtenance, property, or equipment in the City Park, or any property that is placed in the City Park for public accommodation, such as public trash receptacles, public benches, etc.
4. No pets are allowed in the City Park, except for service animals.
5. No intoxicating beverages shall be sold, possessed, or consumed in the City Park, except in conjunction with special events that have received prior written approval from the Board of Alderman.

SECTION 2: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. In the event that any provision of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance are valid unless the Court finds the valid provisions of this ordinance are so essentially and inseparably connected with, and so dependent upon, the void provision that it cannot be presumed that the Board of Aldermen would

the legislative intent.

SECTION 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 4: Effective Upon Passage. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

Read two times and passed this 15th day of July 2009.




