Ordinance No. 221

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A person commits the offense of receiving stolen property if for the purpose of depriving the owner of a lawful interest therein, he receives, retains or disposes of property of another knowing that it has been stolen, or believing that it has been stolen.

Section 2. Evidence of the following is admissible in any prosecution under this section to prove the requisite knowledge or belief of the alleged receiver.

- a. That he was found in possession or control of other property stolen on separate occasions from two or more persons.
- b. That he received other stolen property in another transaction within the year preceding the transaction charged; or
- c. That he acquired the stolen property for a consideration which he know was far below its reasonable value.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of violation of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of committing a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00 or imprisonment in the county jail for up to 90 days or both such fine and imprisonment. (ref:RSMo570.080.)

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon enactment and approval by the City Council.
