
ORDINANCE NO. 228

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE SETTING A CURFEW FOR MINORS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FOLEY ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FOLEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: That Cities of the 4<sup>th</sup> Class, Foley being such, have the authority to establish a curfew thereunder.
- Section 2: That no minor under the age of 17 years shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll, drive or ride in any wheeled vehicle or play in or on the city streets, park, public ways or vacant lots inside the City between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day. This Section shall not apply to a minor accompanied by his parent or guardian or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or directed by his parent or guardian.
- Section 3: That no parent or guardian shall knowingly allow such minor to violate the curfew.
- Section 4: Any officer finding a child violating this Ordinance shall return the child to his parent or guardian, and if such parent or guardian cannot readily be located, shall contact the appropriate juvenile office.
- Section 5: Any parent or guardian found in violation of this Section shall be liable for a find not to exceed \$500.00 or imprisonment in the Lincoln County Jail not to exceed 90 days or both such fine and imprisonment.
- Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval.
